- Share your PTA projects and achievements.
- Communicate your message to other councils and units!

All displays are recognized with a participation award. Displays are also eligible for additional awards and are judged utilizing guidelines important to good visual communication. Your display should strive to:

- Present your message visually and clearly. Simplicity is the key to an exhibit being understandable and visually pleasing.
- Include posters, flyers, portfolios, photographs, collages, 3D exhibits, etc., that you have used throughout the school year.
- Promote your PTA, including special events, activities, projects and/or parent and student education programs.
- Be original. **Make sure to observe all copyright laws if using quoted materials.**
- Identify the name of unit, council, and district. This information must be visible on the front of your exhibit. Remember, there are **no periods in PTA or PTSA.**

Please note: Exhibits may be set up between 8:30 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. only. **No exhibits can be set up after 9:15 a.m.** Bring all supplies needed to mount posters, etc. There will be one table per council.
